- Candidates will be informed about acceptance of abstract ASAP after receiving it.

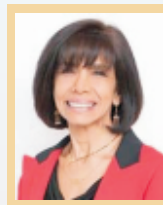

## SIGHT SEEING :

### ABOUT NAVI MUMBAI

Navi Mumbai (also known by its former name New Bombay), is a planned city off the west coast of the Indian state of Maharashtra in Konkan division. The city is divided into two parts, North Navi Mumbai and South Navi Mumbai, for the individual development of Panvel Mega City, which includes the area from Kharghar to Uran. Navi Mumbai has various recreational facilities such as a Golf course, Central Park and Pandavkada Water falls in Kharghar, Parsik Hill near Belapur, Wonders Park and Jewel of Navi Mumbai in Seawoods, Mini Seashore Juhu Chowpatty in Juhu Nagar or Sagar Vihar in Vashi, Pirwad and Mankeshwar Beach in Uran, and several other public places like gardens and jogging tracks. Navi Mumbai also has many quality restaurants and luxury hotels for accommodation, like Four Points by Sheraton, The Park, Fortune Exotica, etc. There are many shopping malls, such as Seawoods Grand Central Mall in Seawoods, Little World mall in Kharghar, Orion Mall in Panvel, Inorbit and Raghuleela Mall in Vashi.

### Kharghar

Kharghar is a smart city of the node of Mumbai metropolis situated at the Northern most tip of Raigad district. It was developed by the City and Industrial Development Corporation i.e. CIDCO. Kharghar is located on the Sion Panvel Highway at one and half hour (approx.) drive during peak traffic hours from the heart of Mumbai city.



### Mumbai Gateway Of India

It takes 57 minutes to travel from Kharghar to Mumbai Gateway Of India. Approximate driving distance between Kharghar and Mumbai Gateway Of India is 48 kms or 29.8 miles Travel time refers to the time taken if the distance is covered by a car.

### Elephanta Caves

Elephanta Caves are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a collection of five Hindu caves and a few Buddhist stupa mounds that date back to the 2nd century BCE, as well as a small group of two Buddhist caves with water tanks. They are located on Elephanta Island, or Gharapuri in Mumbai Harbour. It takes around 3h 6m from Kharghar to reach the caves. One needs to travel by train and ferry from Kharghar to reach Elephanta Caves (Station). One can travel by the train to Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus and then taking the ferry from Gateway of India, Colaba, Mumbai to Elephanta Caves.
